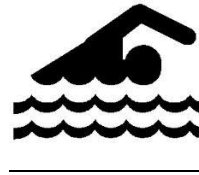


Senior Olympics:

The Rio Arriba County Local Senior Olympic Qualifying Games are held annually during the month of May at the Espanola Valley High School Facilities. Local Senior Olympic Game Registrations are open to all residents 50 years of age on. The fee to register for Local Games is \$ 15.00 per person for participation of up to ten events.

Bowling and golf require additional fees; applications can be picked up at the Recreation Department Office located at 1122 Industrial Park Road. Participants should register according to their age groups, age categories for both men's and women's are 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+, with the exception of bowling teams, dance and talent competitions. Talent and dance competitions have two age categories 50-69, and 70+, bowling team's age divisions are 50 +, 55+, 60+, 70+, 75+, 80+.

Age categories for doubles and teams are determined by the youngest player on the roster. Senior athletes that qualify at the Local Games are eligible to compete at the New Mexico State Summer Games .New Mexico. Senior athletes that qualify at the State Level qualify to compete at the National Level (location to be determined). Now recruiting senior 50+ to join and compete in 26 various events and 3 team tournaments which include: Volleyball teams: Men's, Women's, and Co-ED teams, Softball teams: Men's and Women's teams, 3 on 3 Basketball Team's: Men's and Women's Teams, team tournaments will be held at different locations.
