Request for Quotes, Trainer in Harm Reduction and Overdose Prevention

Rio Arriba Health and Human Services is seeking a contractor that will provide harm reduction training to EMTs. Contractor shall provide the following services:

- Two (2) hours of harm reduction training to sixteen (16) Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) students in a classroom setting, per semester for three semesters (fall, winter, and spring);
- Two (2) hours of training in trauma informed care to the EMT students per semester in a classroom setting for three semesters;
- Two (2) four-hour trainings in Mental Health First Aid to the EMT students in a classroom setting per semester for three semesters;
- Dispensation of Narcan kits to the EMT students per semester for three semesters;
- Be responsible for providing certifications for trainings in collaboration with RAC's Health and Human Services Department (HHS) and the academic institution designated.
- Conduct 425 individual overdose prevention training sessions to first responders, volunteer firefighters and others identified for training through the SAMHSA First Responder grant
- Provide RAC's Health and Human Services Department (HHS) with all required data, entering it, into the HHS data system
- Maintain appropriate files, making them available to HHS
- Provide at least 100 hours of case management services to shared clients maintaining DAP notes and other relevant information in the HHS Electronic Health Record
- Meet regularly with HHS and assist the Rio Arriba Community Health Council Overdose Prevention Task Force to develop Fentanyl and Methamphetamine Response Plans.

Applicants should answer the following questions in the responses.

1. Provide appropriate certification(s) for your area of practice (25 points)
2. Describe your experience in the areas of harm reduction? (25 points)
3. Describe your experience in working with underprivileged population? (25 points)
4. Provide your hourly rate for services. (25 points)
